- 21,000 women targeted
- 28 modernized, handcrafted shea butter and kernel processing centers
 - Better working conditions
 - Higher productivity
 - Lower CO2 footprint
 - Higher income
 - Lower cost
- Women empowerment: trainings in business management, shea collection, processing, and production practices that meet international standards



\$1.4M grant from USAID West Africa Trade Hub, matched with an additional \$1.3M from SheaMoisture

Vision: to generate a lasting value even after the end of Shea Gets Greener project

Action: The KPI indicators in Shea Gets Greener project to become regular environmental & social (E&S) performance indicators, for each cooperative

E&S Indicators to be synthetized through a standardized notation system
